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## **Advancing Research and Pedagogy in Chinese Language Education : IJCLT Conference on Chinese Language Teaching and Research First Call**

### **Background**

In response to the complex needs of high-quality international Chinese language education in the new era, the Centre for Research and Development of Putonghua Education at The Chinese University of Hong Kong, in collaboration with the International Journal of Chinese Language Teaching (IJCLT), will host *Advancing Research and Pedagogy in Chinese Language Education: IJCLT Conference on Chinese Language Teaching and Research*. This conference aims to establish a high-level platform for academic dialogue across countries and regions, share cutting-edge research findings, and promote the further development of IJCLT.

Since its establishment in 1998, the Centre for Research and Development of Putonghua Education at The Chinese University of Hong Kong has been deeply engaged in Putonghua training, assessment, and promotion in Hong Kong, while also supporting the education and professional development of international Chinese language teachers and conducting related research. Its services reach all sectors of Hong Kong society, and its influence extends to mainland China and beyond. IJCLT is a diamond open-access journal dedicated to advancing research and practice in international Chinese language education. Its scope encompasses both Chinese as a first language and Chinese as a second or foreign language.

- **Colloquia:** Conveners should submit a Word document, including: the title and overall introduction of the colloquia (within 300 Chinese characters or 500 English words); the title, abstract, and keywords of each presentation in the colloquia (each within 300 Chinese characters or 500 English words).
- **Individual paper presentations:** Please submit the paper title, abstract, and keywords (within 300 Chinese characters or 500 English words).
- The abstract should include key information such as research background/rationale, research methods, and findings.
- The working language of this conference is Chinese or English.
- Abstract submission: Submit through the online form. The deadline is **14 February 2027**. The abstract submission channel will open after the Second Call.
- Acceptance notification: Participants will be notified by email before **22 February 2027**.

All submitted abstracts will be included in the Book of Abstracts to be published by Clifford Publishing.

After the conference, participants may submit full manuscripts. Subject to peer review and satisfactory revisions, all papers will be published in IJCLT or included in the post-conference edited volumes.
